## Interschools Competition 2010

In July this year the 5 Leijer children competed at the Subaru State Interschools competition with outstanding results as you'll see below.

The children will be competing again in Thredbo at the end of August. Good luck kids!

- Sophie - Year 10: Division 2 (Years 9 and 10) in moguls (her Ravenswood team came 4<sup>th</sup>)
- Emily - Year 8: Division 3 (Years 7 and 8) in moguls (she came 2<sup>nd</sup> individually for Ravenswood) , in Ski x (she came 4<sup>th</sup> and her team came 3<sup>rd</sup>) and in Alpine (she came 7<sup>th</sup>). Emily also came 7<sup>th</sup> in the Scots cup.
- Natalie - Year 5: Division 4 (Years 5 and 6) in moguls (she came 4<sup>th</sup> and her Ravenswood team 1<sup>st</sup>), in ski x (she came 2<sup>nd</sup> and her team 1<sup>st</sup>) and in Alpine (she came 2<sup>nd</sup> and her team 1<sup>st</sup>). Natalie also came 1<sup>st</sup> in the Scots cup and was also awarded the trophy for the fastest female primary age student.
- Nicholas - Year 3: Division 5 (Kindy to Year 4) in moguls (he came 3<sup>rd</sup> and his Shore team came 3<sup>rd</sup>), in Ski x (his team came 5<sup>th</sup>)

## **Background**

The Perisher Cup is one of the oldest and most prestigious ski competitions in Australia. First run in 1954, skiers represent their club as a team in this three discipline event – Giant Slalom, Cross Country and Jump. This interclub competition has continued thanks to a collection of clubs who enjoy friendly interclub competition, respect the tradition of the race and enjoy a great social weekend. There are three classes of competition – the open event, women's event and novice event.

Traditionally, the competition was held on the October Long Weekend, but has been brought forward due to lack of snow reliability late in the season. A team of four persons must compete in all events to achieve the best aggregate score (no substitutions).

Six years ago Cooma Ski Club took on the task of running this annual event, although assistance from other clubs is greatly appreciated.

All Clubs wishing to participate in this fun, yet traditional competition this year should register their interest by Anthony or Kylie – this includes recent past supporting clubs!
